In the event of a regime change, progress in Russia cannot take place within the current institutional framework. Moreover, a break with Putin’s legacy is unthinkable unless those responsible for the war in Ukraine, as well as those involved in human rights abuses inside Russia are held accountable. Such are the prevailing attitudes that emerge in data interviews with more than 200 Russian citizens who fled the country after February 24, 2022.

Mikhail Turchenko is currently a visiting scholar in the IU Ostrom Workshop. He previously held the position of senior lecturer in political science at the European University (Saint Petersburg, Russia). His publications include numerous peer-reviewed articles in English and Russian.
